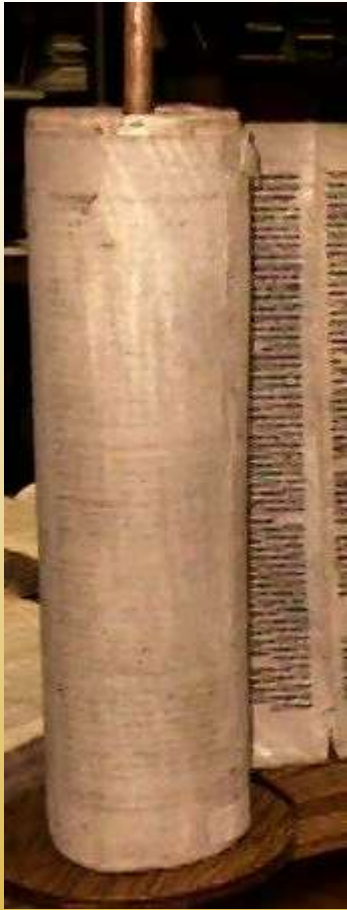

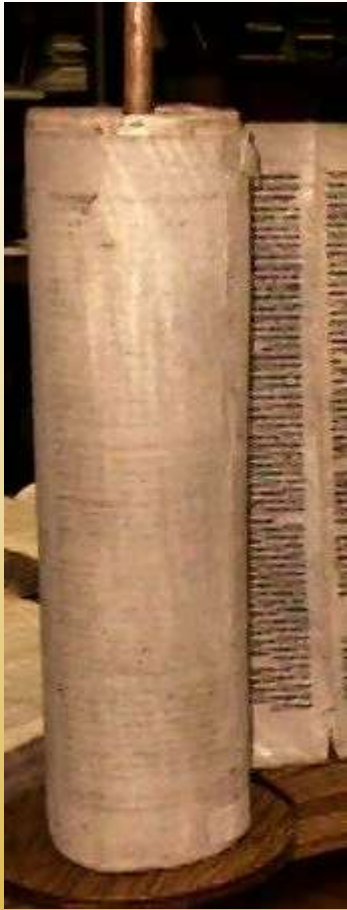

Kings: Judah and Israel

- 1 Kings
 - Solomon
 - Judah: Rehoboam thru Jehoshaphat
 - Israel: Jeroboam thru Ahab
- 2 Kings
 - Judah: Jehoshaphat thru Zedekiah
 - Israel: Ahaziah thru Hoshea

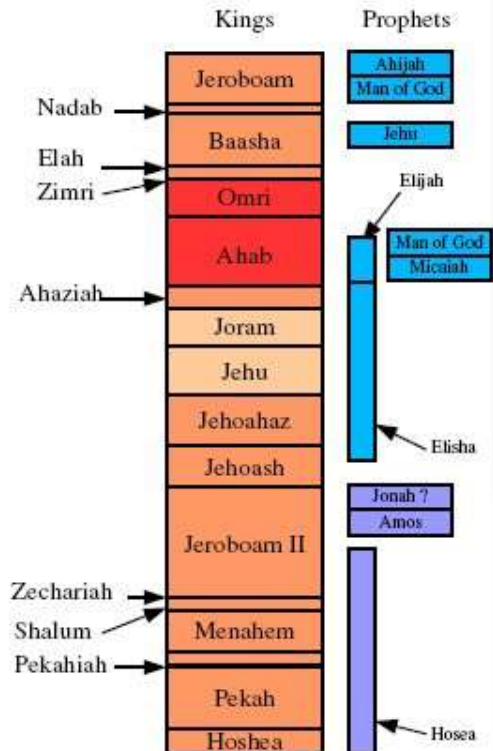

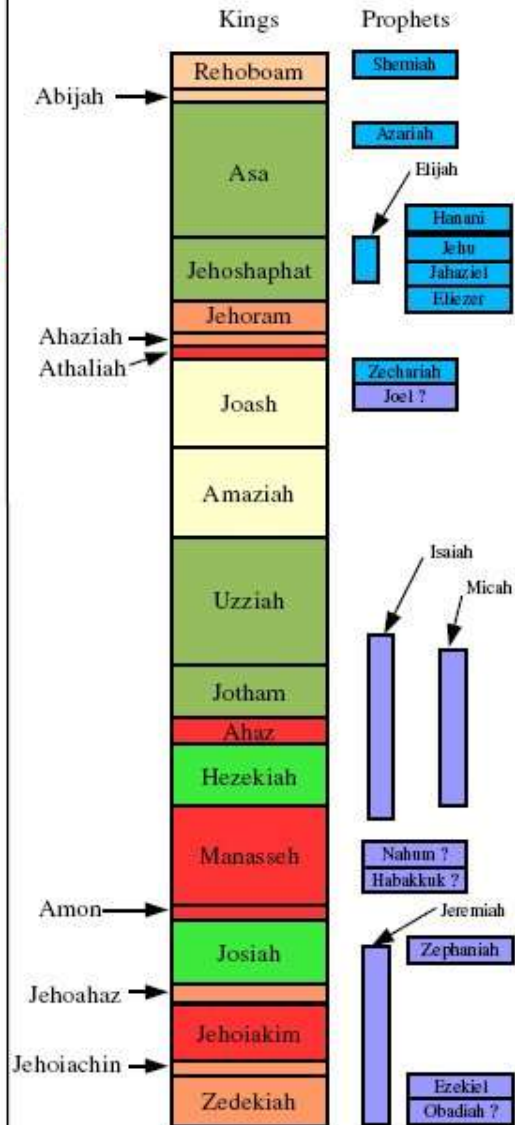
Prophet who did not write book

Prophet who wrote book of Bible

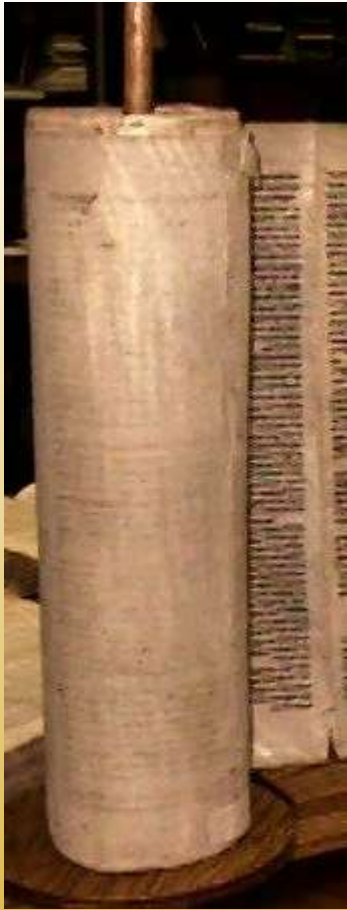

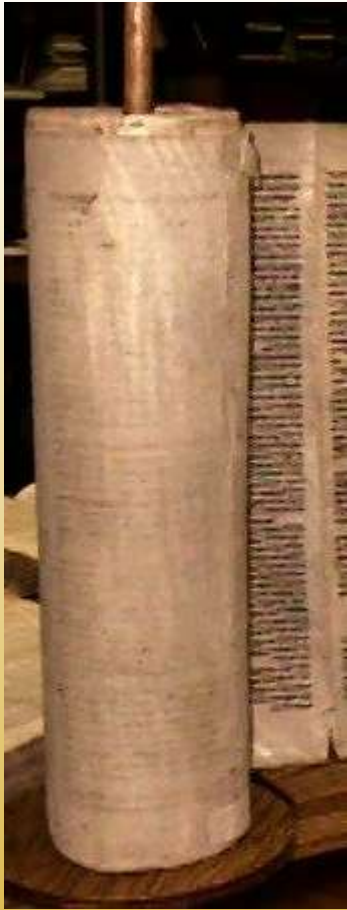

Asa king of Judah

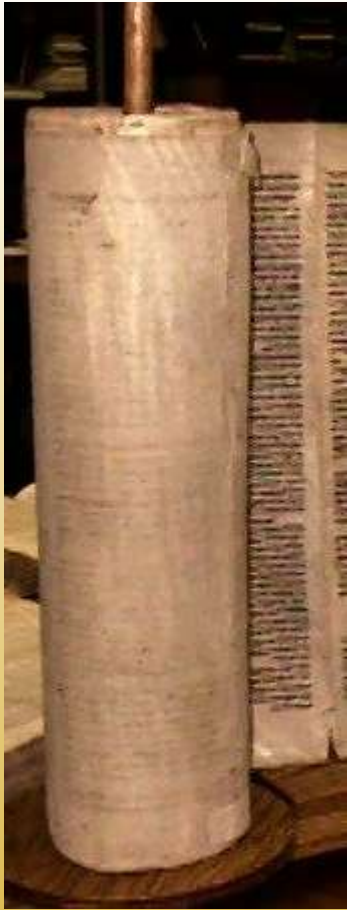
- Third king of Judah in divided era
- 1 King 15
- 2 Chron 14-16
- Ruled 41 years
- Mostly good king



Old Testament Survey

Asa king of Judah: good and bad

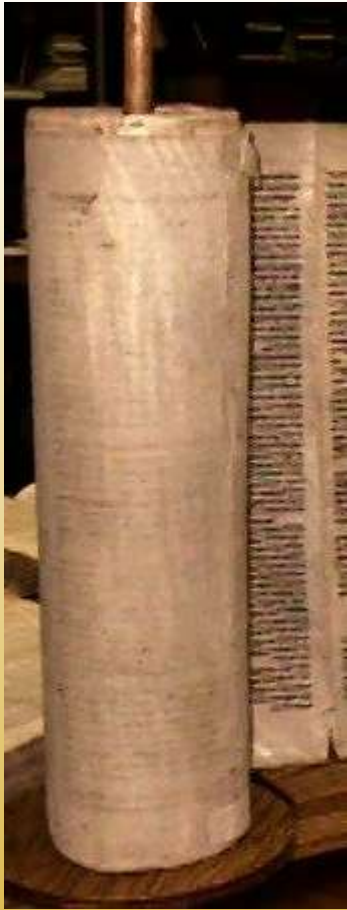
- Fully committed to LORD all his life
 - 2 Chron 15:17
- Relied on Aram for help against Israel
 - 2 Chron 16:7-10



Old Testament Survey

Ahab king of Israel: bad king

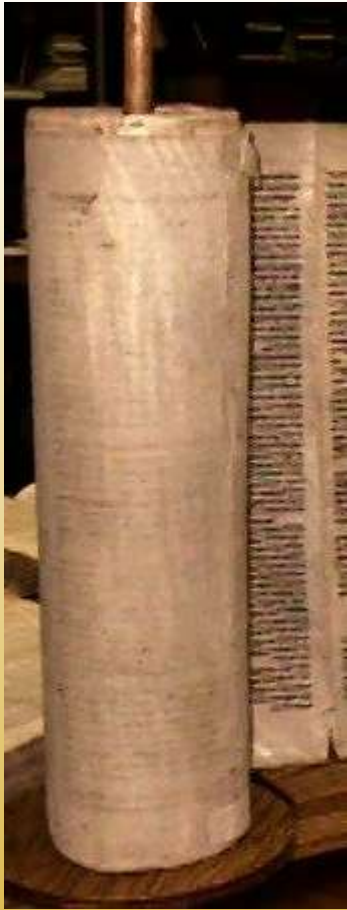
- 1 Kings 16-22
- Seventh king of Israel in divided era
- *“Ahab son of Omri did more evil in the eyes of the LORD than any of those before him.”* 1 King 16:30



Old Testament Survey

Events of Ahab's reign

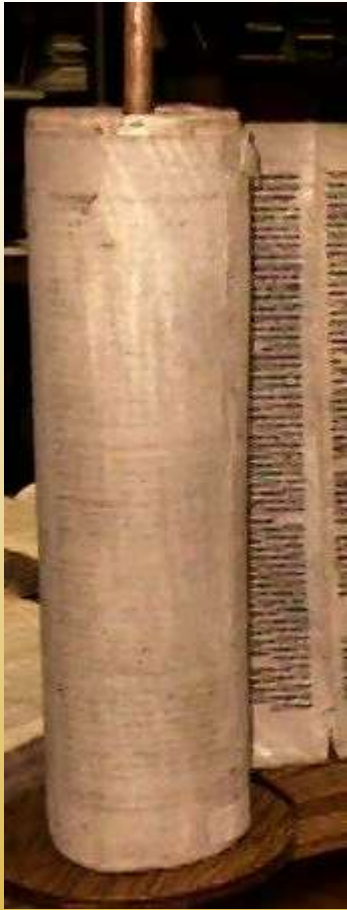
- Jezebel kills prophets (1 Kin 18:4)
- Elijah, drought in Israel (1 Kin 17:1)
- Elijah on Mount Carmel (1 Kin 18:23)
- God delivers Israel from Aram (1 Ki 20)
- Naboth's vineyard (1 Ki 21)



Old Testament Survey

Elijah confronts Ahab

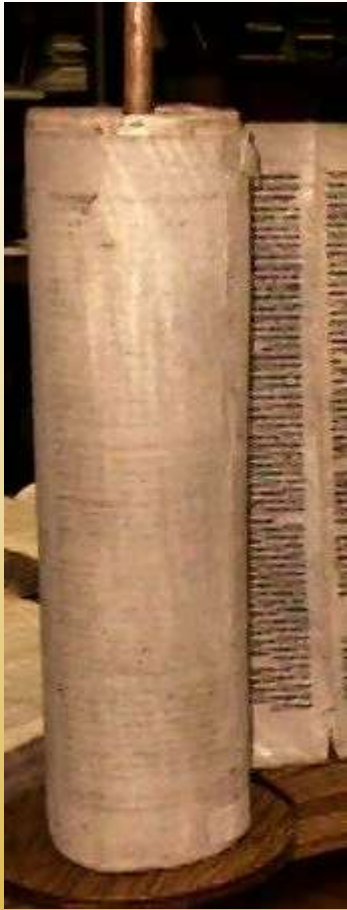
- 1 Kings 21:16-29
- *"Have you noticed how Ahab has humbled himself before me? Because he has humbled himself, I will not bring this disaster in his day, but I will bring it on his house in the days of his son."*



Old Testament Survey

Elijah and Elisha

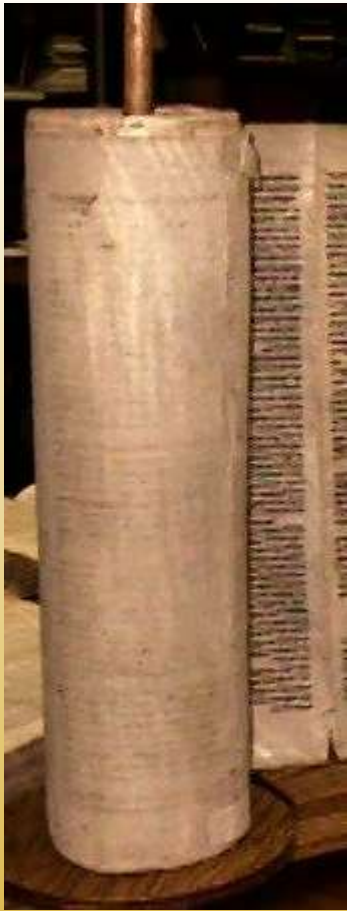
- 2 Kings 2
- Elijah taken up to heaven
- Elisha receives double portion



Old Testament Survey

Elisha's miracles

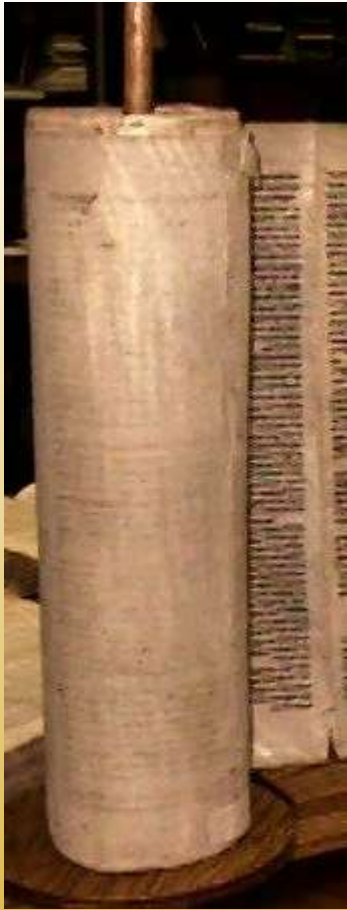
- Healing the water (2 Kings 2)
- Widow's oil (2 Kings 4)
- Shunammite's son (2 Kings 4)
- Naaman's leprosy (2 Kings 5)
- Axe-head floats (2 Kings 6)
- Traps blind Arameans (2 Kings 6)



Old Testament Survey

Siege of Samaria (2 Kings 6-7)

- Joram son of Ahab, 2 Kings 3:1
- As prophesied against Ahab (1 Kings 21:29)
- Severe famine
- God frightens Aramean armies away
- Lepers discover food in camp



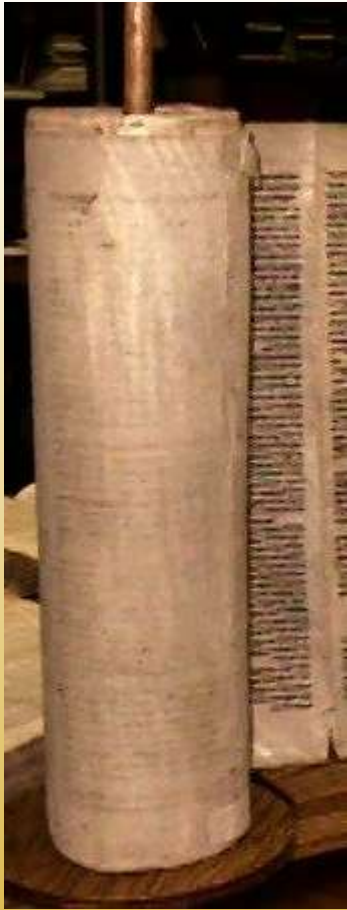
Old Testament Survey

King Uzziah (Azariah) of Judah

- 2 Kings 15; 2 Chron 26

King Jeroboam II of Israel

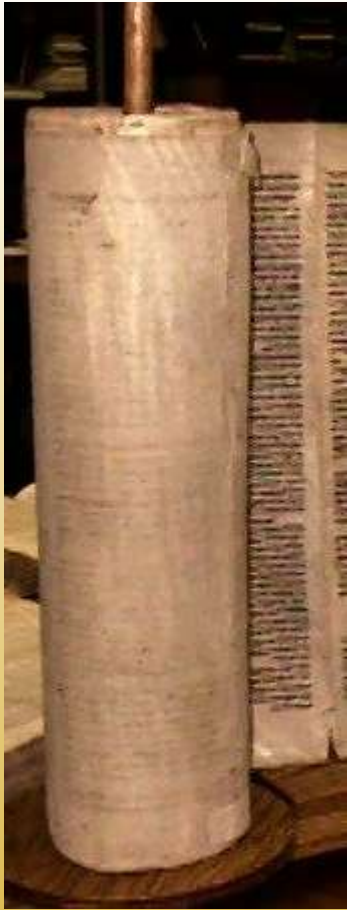
- 2 Kings 14



Old Testament Survey

Amos

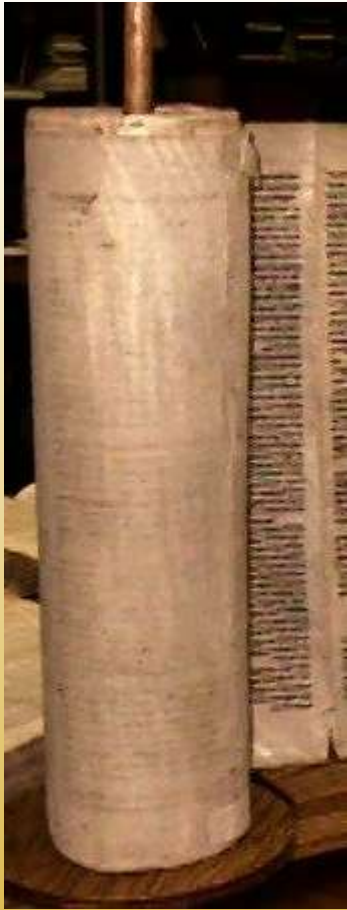
- during time of Uzziah and Jeroboam II
 - Amos 1:1
- Prophesied against
 - Israel's neighbors
 - Judah (Jerusalem to be burned)
 - Israel to be destroyed



Old Testament Survey

Hosea

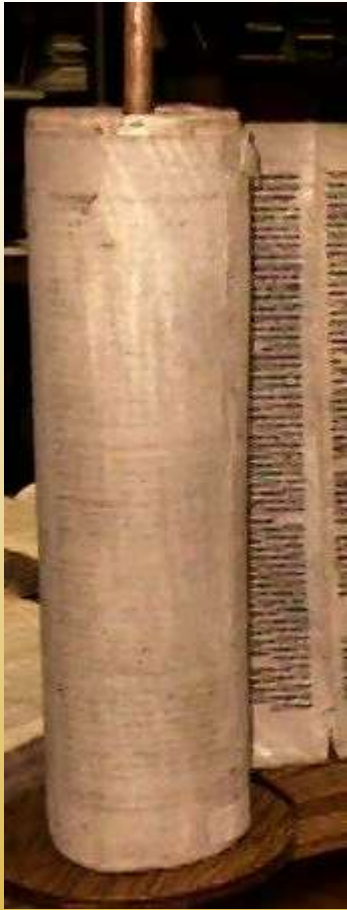
- From Uzziah through Hezekiah; Jeroboam
- Israel an adultress
- Hos 1:4
 - *“Will soon punish house of Jehu”*
 - *“I will put an end to the kingdom of Israel”*



Old Testament Survey

Fall of Israel to Assyria

- Menahem pays Assyria to spare Israel
 - 2 Kin 15:19-20
- Pekah loses much of Israel to Assyria
 - 2 Kin 15:28-29
- Hoshea loses remainder of Israel
 - 2 Kin 17:6
- Israelites deported to Assyria
- Assyrians resettle Samaria

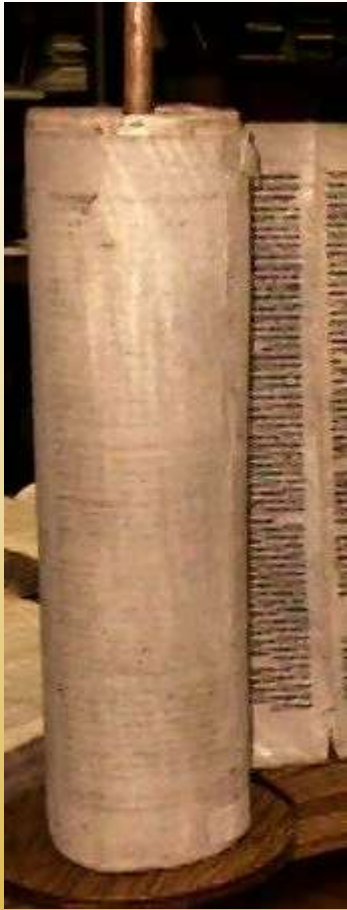


Old Testament

Hezekiah king of Judah

2 Kings 18-20; 2 Chron 29-32; Isaiah 36-39

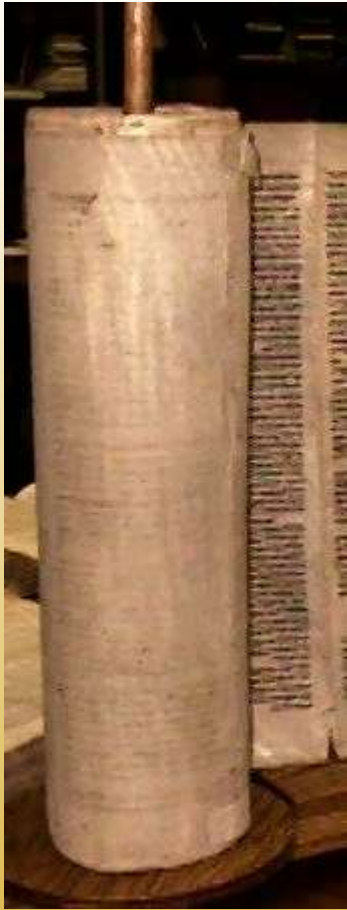
- Good king; removed high places
- Sennacherib captures much of Judah
 - 2 Kin 18:13
- God intervenes (2 Kin 18:35-36)
 - kills 185,000 Assyrian soldiers
- God extends Hezekiah's life
 - 2 Kin 20



Old Testament Survey

Babylonian envoys visit

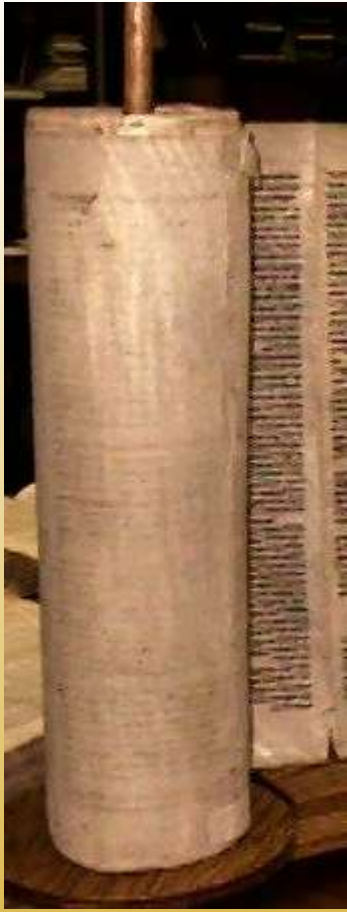
- 2 Kings 20; Isaiah 39
- Saw the wealth of Judah
- Isaiah prophesied that it would all be taken by Babylon



Old Testament Survey

Micah

- During Jotham, Ahaz, Hezekiah
- Judgment on Israel and Judah
- Israel's sin had come to Judah Mic 1:9
- Jerusalem to become rubble heap
- Prophecies about Jesus, Bethlehem
- Word to go out from Jerusalem

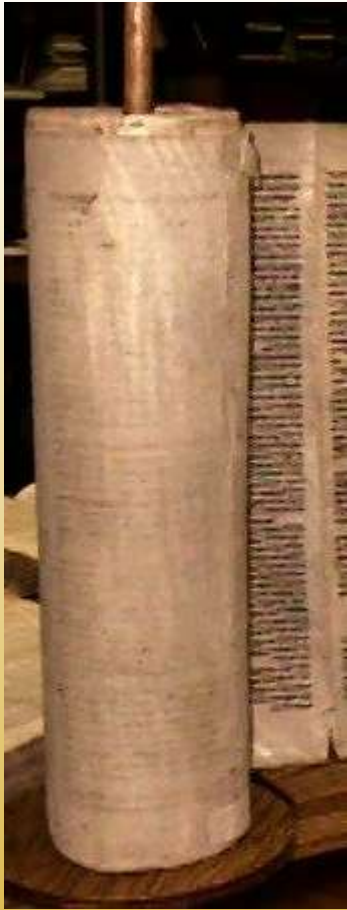


Old Testament Survey

Manasseh

2 Kings 21; 2 Chron 33

- Very Evil king
- *2 Kin 21:12 “I am going to bring such disaster on Jerusalem and Judah that the ears of everyone who hears of it will tingle”*

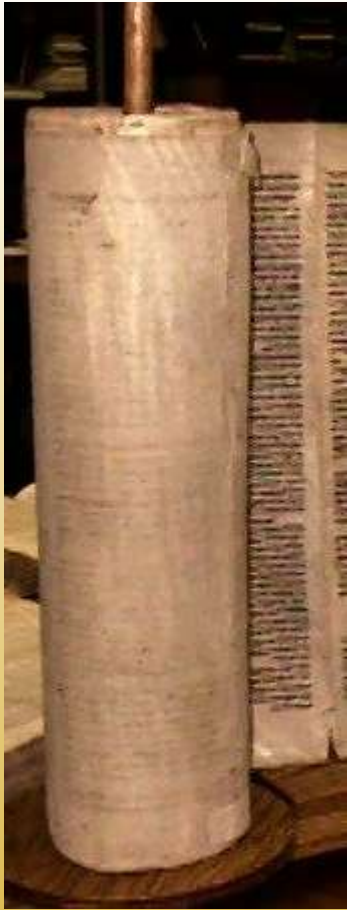


Old Testament Survey

Prophecy against Manasseh

Jeremiah 15

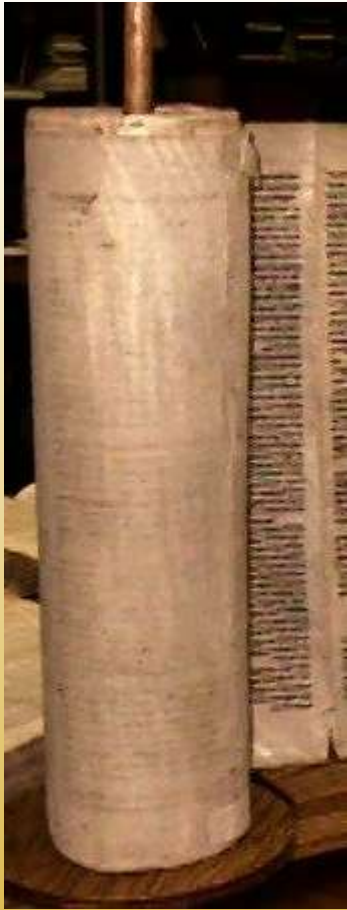
- *Even if Moses and Samuel were to stand before me, my heart would not go out to this people*
- *I will make them abhorrent to all the kingdoms of the earth because of what Manasseh son of Hezekiah king of Judah did in Jerusalem*



Old Testament Survey

Josiah

- 2 Kings 22-23; 2 Chron 34-35
- Good king
- Discovered book of Law
- Destroyed idol worship



Old Testament Survey

Zephaniah

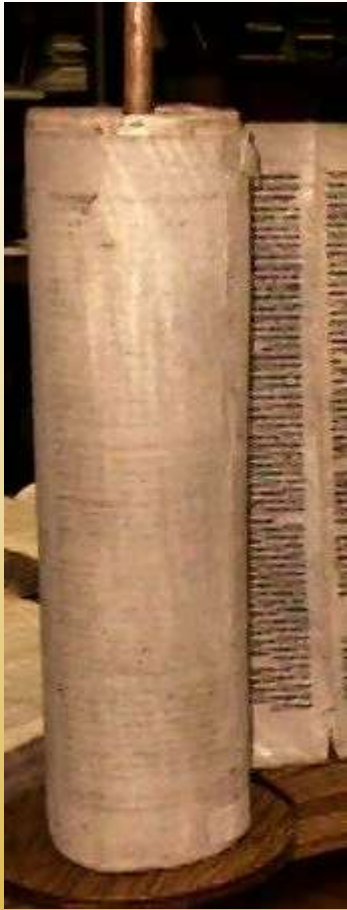
- During reign of Josiah
- *“I will sweep away everything from the face of the earth.”*
- *“The whole world will be consumed by the fire of my jealous anger. “*
- Zion to be restored



Old Testament Survey

Jeremiah during Josiah's time

- Jer 3:6-11
- Judah should have learned from Israel's fate



Old Testament Survey

Jehoahaz succeeds Josiah

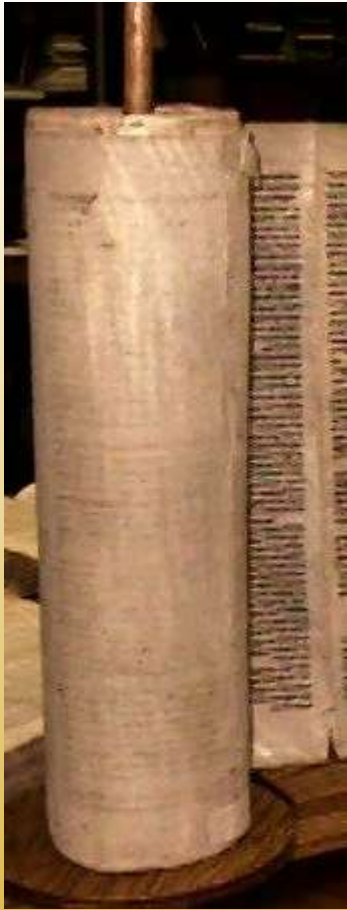
- Carried off to Egypt (2 King 23:34)
- Jer 22:11-30
 - Jer 22:11 refers to Jehoahaz
 - Jehoahaz, Jehoakim, Jehoiachin
 - Nebuchadnezzar



Old Testament Survey

Nebuchadnezzar

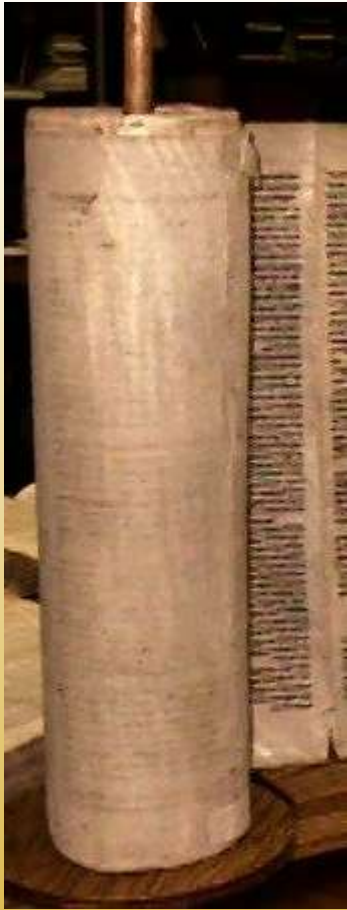
- Jeremiah prophecies (Jer 25)
- subjugates Jehoiakim (2 King 24)



Old Testament Survey

Nebuchadnezzar captures Jerusalem, Zedekiah

- Predicted, Jer 25
- 2 Kings 24-25; 2 Chron 36; Jer 34
- 2 King 24:20, 2 King 25
- Ezek 17 (compare Jer 39)
