Remembering deliverance Exodus 13

- Firstborn consecrated to God
- Feast of Unleavened Bread
- Redeem (buy back) firstborn son



Joseph's bones

Exo 13:19

Moses took the bones of Joseph with him because Joseph had made the sons of Israel swear an oath. He had said, "God will surely come to your aid, and then you must carry my bones up with you from this place."



God led them

- Avoided the Philistines
- Pillar of cloud by day
- Pillar of fire by night
- Avoided confrontation with Philistines



Crossing the Red Sea Exodus 14

- Pharaoh changed mind
- Army, chariots pursued Israelites
- Angel stood between Egyptians and Israelites



Parting the Red Sea (Exodus 14)

- Moses stretched hand toward sea
- Strong east wind all night
- Sea parted, crossed on dry ground
- God fought for Israelites



Israelites crossed Red Sea

- Egyptians followed
- God threw them into confusion
- Waters returned, swept away Egyptians



People grumble (Exodus 16)

- God sends quail in the evening
- Manna in the morning
 - -gather daily for 6 days
 - -on 6th day gather double
 - do not gather on Sabbath
- People did not obey



Grumbling Israelites

- Bricks without straw Ex 5:20-21
- Fear of Pharaoh's army Ex 14:11-12
- Bitter water Ex 15:24
- Food Ex 16:3
- Water Ex 17:2-3



Exodus 17

- Water from a rock at Horeb
- Amalekites attack, are defeated



Jethro visits (Exodus 18)

- Advice about delegation
- Deut 1:9-18



Mount Sinai (Exodus 19)

- Dense cloud
- Whoever touches the mountain shall surely be put to death.
- Moses receives ten commandments



Ten Commandments (Exodus 20)

- 1. No other gods
- 2. No images / idols
- 3. Do not misuse God's name
- 4. Sabbath day
- 5. Honor your parents



Ten Commandments (cont'd)

- 6. Do not murder
- 7. Do not commit adultery
- 8. Do not steal
- 9. Do not give false testimony
- 10. Do not covet



Exodus 21-31: Miscellaneous laws Moses on Mt Sinai for 40 days



The golden calf (Exodus 32)

- Moses gone a long time
- People asked Aaron to make idol
- "These are your gods [elohiym], O Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt."



Moses pleads for Israel

- What would the Egyptians think??
- Remember promise to Abraham
- God relents
- "However, when the time comes for me to punish, I will punish them for their sin."



Moses and the Glory of the LORD Exodus 33:12-23

- Teach me your ways
- Request for God's presence
- Show me your glory



God gives Moses new tablets

Exodus 34:28

Moses was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights without eating bread or drinking water. And he wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant-the Ten Commandments.



Moses and the veil

- Spoke with the LORD
- Face radiant
- Told people what God said
- Then veiled face



1 Cor 3:7-18

- Veil had a symbolic meaning
- Covenant pointed toward Christ
- Israelites did not understand
- Only shown as much as they could accept (veiled message)
- Mosaic Covenant would fade away
- In Christ the veil is taken away



The Tabernacle Exodus 35-40

- Mobile precursor to the temple
- Filled with the glory of the LORD
- > Ex 40:34-38
