What is "unwholesome talk?"

Rom 3:12 All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not even one."

Rom 3:13 "Their throats are open graves; their tongues practice deceit." "The poison of vipers is on their lips." Rom 3:14 "Their mouths are full of cursing and bitterness."

What is "unwholesome talk?"

Col 3:8 But now you must rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips.

What is "unwholesome talk?"

Profanity

You know what it is.

- vulgar words about sex
- certain bodily functions
- misuse of God's name and other sacred things
- usually an emotional outburst for emphasis
- no regard for the actual meaning of the words

Get rid of the filthy language from your lips!

What is "unwholesome talk?"

"Soft profanity" - words that "sound like" profanity - profanity for "polite company" - darn, dang, shoot, freakin', cotton pickin' ...

Jas 3:9 With the tongue we praise our Lord and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in God's likeness. Jas 3:10 Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing. My brothers, this should not be.

What is "unwholesome talk?"

Jas 5:12 Above all, my brothers, do not swear —not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. Let your "Yes" be yes, and your "No," no, or you will be condemned.

Mat 5:37 Simply let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one.

What is "unwholesome talk?"

Pro 17:27 A man of knowledge uses words with restraint, and a man of understanding is even-tempered.

Mat 12:34b For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks.
