


Rom 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Rom 1:18 The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness


Previously

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
Rom 3:9 What shall we conclude then? Are we any better? Not at all! We have already made the charge that Jews and Gentiles alike are all under sin.

Charges of sin from the OT

Rom 3:10 As it is written: "There is no one righteous, not even one; Rom 3:11 there is no one who understands, no one who seeks God. Rom 3:12 All have turned away, they have together become worthless; there is no one who does good, not even one."



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
Psa 14:1 The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, their deeds are vile; there is no one who does good.

Psa 14:2 The LORD looks down from heaven on the sons of men to see if there are any who understand, any who seek God.

Psa 14:3 All have turned aside, they have together become corrupt; there is no one who does good, not even one.

Charges of sin from the OT

Rom 3:13 "Their throats are open graves; their tongues practice deceit." "The poison of vipers is on their lips."



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Psa 5:9 Not a word from their mouth can be trusted; their heart is filled with destruction. Their throat is an open grave; with their tongue they speak deceit.

Charges of sin from the OT


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Psa 140:3 They make their tongues as sharp as a serpent's; the poison of vipers is on their lips.

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
Psa 10:7 His mouth is full of curses and lies and threats; trouble and evil are under his tongue.

Charges of sin from the OT

Rom 3:15 "Their feet are swift to shed blood;

Rom 3:16 ruin and misery mark their ways,

Rom 3:17 and the way of peace they do not know."



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
Rom 3:17 and the way of peace they do not know."

Isa 59:7 Their feet rush into sin; they are swift to shed innocent blood. Their thoughts are evil thoughts; ruin and destruction mark their ways.

Isa 59:8 The way of peace they do not know; there is no justice in their paths. They have turned them into crooked roads; no one who walks in them will know peace.

Rom 3:18 "There is no fear of God before their eyes."



Charges of sin from the OT

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Psa 36:1 An oracle is within my heart concerning the sinfulness of the wicked: There is no fear of God before his eyes.

Charges of sin from the OT

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Living as though there is no God



Accountability for sin

Rom 3:19 Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be silenced and the whole world held accountable to God.

Rom 3:20 Therefore no one will be declared righteous in his sight by observing the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of sin.

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The whole world held accountable

Law made us aware of sin that was already there



Righteousness through faith

Rom 3:21 But now a righteousness from God, apart from law, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify.

Rom 3:22 This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference,

Rom 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Rom 3:24 and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

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Justified through Jesus

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Rom 3:26 he did it to demonstrate his justice at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.

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
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Rom 3:28 For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from observing the law.



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

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
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
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2Pe 3:15 Bear in mind that our Lord's patience means salvation, just as our dear brother Paul also wrote you with the wisdom that God gave him.

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
Use clearer passage to explain difficult passage

Example of Abraham

Rom 4:1 What then shall we say that Abraham, our forefather, discovered in this matter?

Rom 4:2 If, in fact, Abraham was justified by works, he had something to boast about—but not before God.

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Rom 4:10 Under what circumstances was it credited? Was it after he was circumcised, or before? It was not after, but before!

Example of Abraham

Gen 12:1 The LORD had said to Abram, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you. Gen 12:2 "I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.

Gen 12:3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

Gen 12:4 So Abram left, as the LORD had told him; and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he set out from Haran.

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
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Why did God choose Abraham?

Example of Abraham

Gen 15:5 He took him outside and said, "Look up at the heavens and count the stars—if indeed you can count them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be."

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Gen 17:10 This is my covenant with you and your descendants after you, the covenant you are to keep: Every male among you shall be circumcised.

#### Example of Abraham

Gen 22:1 Some time later God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied.

Gen 22:2 Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, Isaac, whom you love, and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains I will tell you about."

Gen 22:3 Early the next morning Abraham got up and saddled his donkey. He took with him two of his servants and his son Isaac. When he had cut enough wood for the burnt offering, he set out for the place God had told him about.

#### Example of Abraham

Gen 22:15 The angel of the LORD called to Abraham from heaven a second time

Gen 22:16 and said, "I swear by myself, declares the LORD, that because you have done this and have not withheld your son, your only son,

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"Because you have obeyed me"

#### Example of Abraham

Jas 2:21 Was not our ancestor Abraham considered righteous for what he did when he offered his son Isaac on the altar?

Jas 2:22 You see that his faith and his actions were working together, and his faith was made complete by what he did.

Jas 2:23 And the scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness," and he was called God's friend.

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
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His actions completed his faith

Jas 2:17 In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.



Rom 4:18 Against all hope, Abraham in hope believed and so became the father of many nations, just as it had been said to him, "So shall your offspring be."

Rom 4:19 Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead—since he was about a hundred years old—and that Sarah's womb was also dead.

Rom 4:20 Yet he did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God,


Rom 4:21 being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised.

Rom 4:22 This is why "it was credited to him as righteousness."


Rom 4:23 The words "it was credited to him" were written not for him alone,

Rom 4:24 but also for us, to whom God will credit righteousness—for us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead.


Rom 4:25 He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.


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
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Rom 1:5 Through him and for his name's sake, we received grace and apostleship to call people from among all the Gentiles to the obedience that comes from faith.

When God sees faith he credits righteousness



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
Obedience comes from faith and completes our faith
