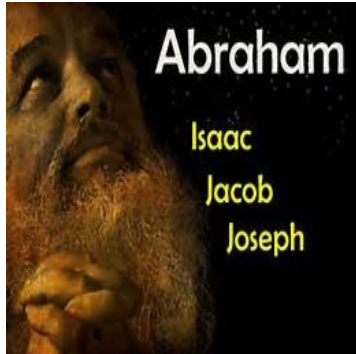

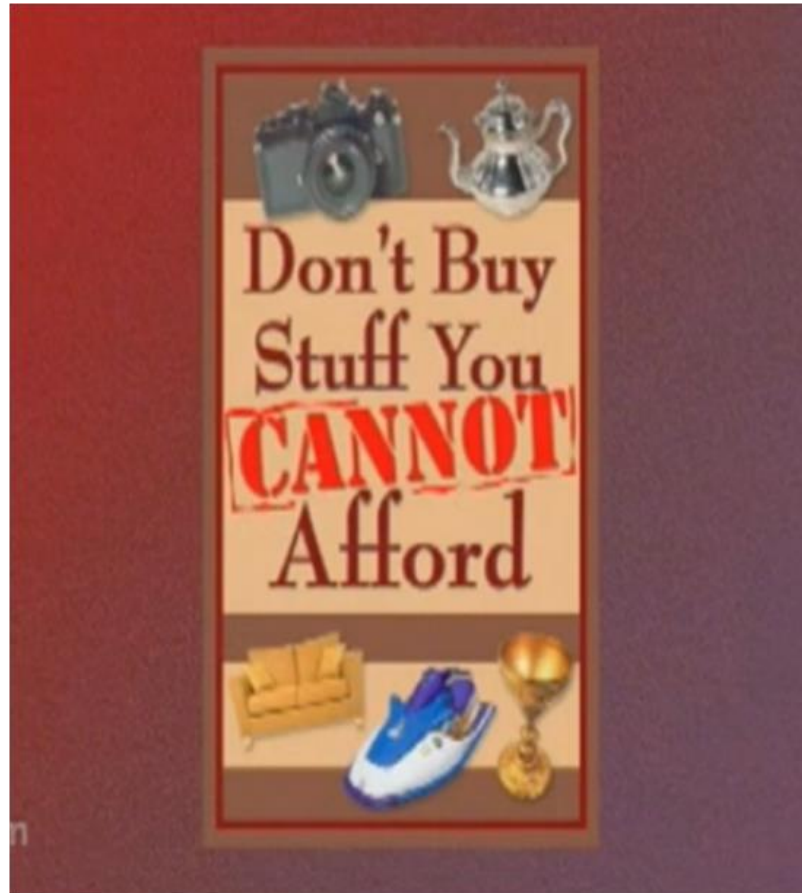
Some Biblical Examples of Faith & Wealth

 - I Chr 29:28 – “He died at a good old age, having enjoyed long life, wealth and honor.”
- Joseph of Arimathea
 - Matt 27:57 – “As evening approached, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus.”

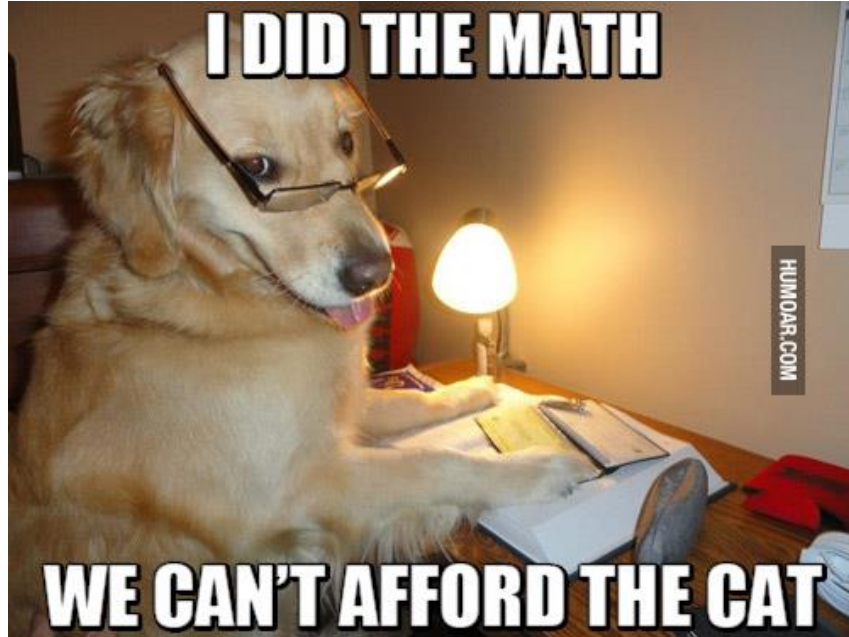

Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law.



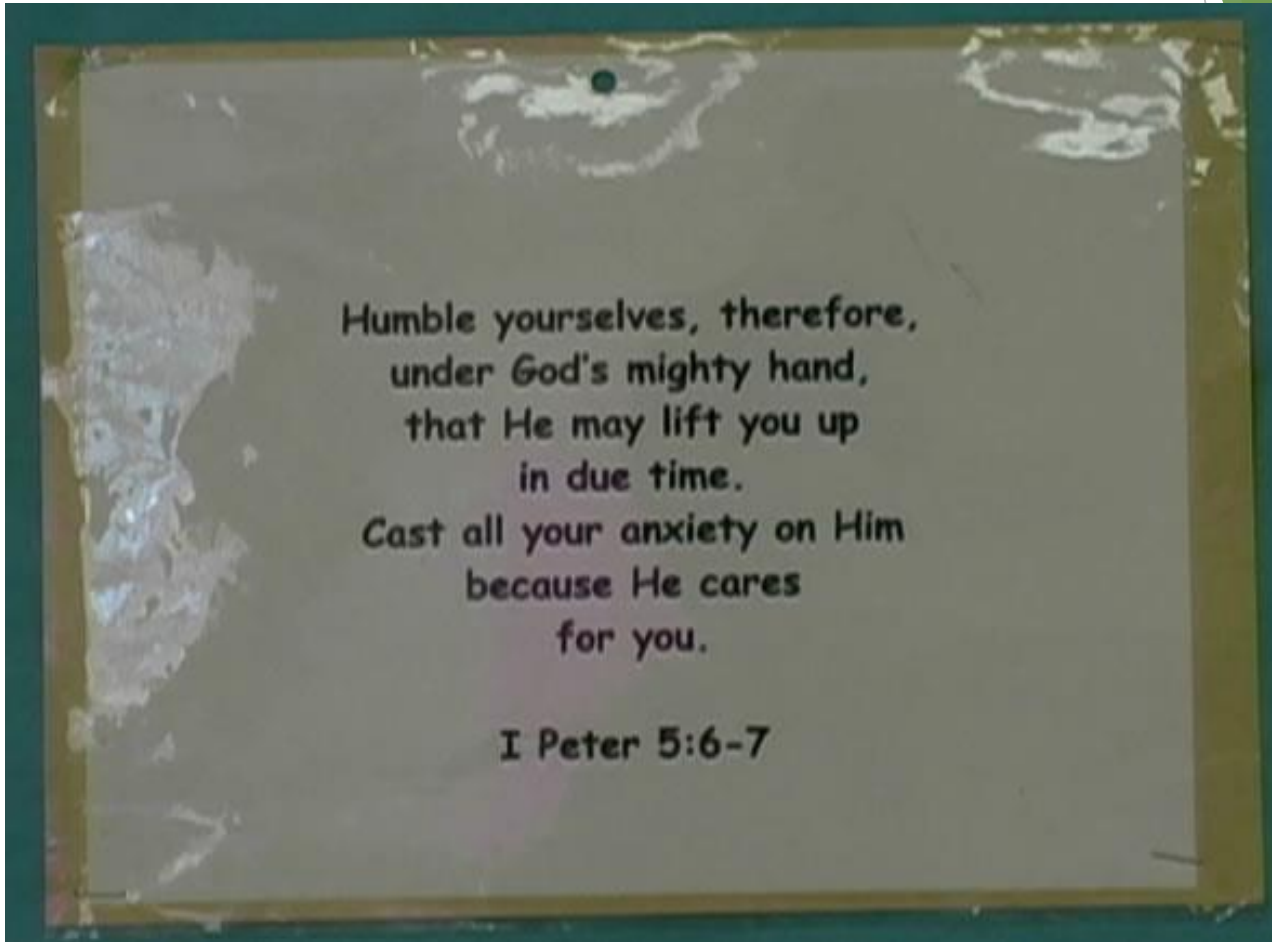


