


Martin Luther and "Faith alone"

Jas 2:21 Was not our ancestor Abraham considered righteous for what he did when he offered his son Isaac on the altar?


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Martin Luther and "Faith alone"

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Jas 2:24 You see that a person is justified by what he does and **not by faith alone.**

Luther called James an "epistle of straw"





Untangling Abraham *Romans*

Rom 4:9b We have been saying that Abraham's faith was credited to him as righteousness.

Rom 4:10 Under what circumstances was it credited? Was it after he was circumcised, or before? It was not after, but before!

Not because of circumcision

Rom 4:13 It was not through law that Abraham and his offspring received the promise that he would be heir of the world, but through the righteousness that comes by faith.



Gen 12:3 I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."


Why? God did not say!




Untangling Abraham *Genesis*

Gen 22:18 and through your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed, because you have obeyed me."

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
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



Genesis


God made the promises in chapters 12, 15, 17 because he knew what Abraham would do in chapter 22.

Because of Abraham's obedient faith!














Rom 5:12-21 has been usually regarded as the most difficult part of the New Testament. - Albert Barnes' commentary

Because people have tried to make it teach something it does not teach



Completing the thought begun in verse 12



Adam's sin





Gen 3:19 By the sweat of your brow you will eat your food until you return to the ground, since from it you were taken; for dust you are and to dust you will return."




Untangling Adam Physical death

Sin had entered the world. Now man would be tempted to choose evil.




Untangling Adam Physical death

Rom 5:19 For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous.


One righteous life brought righteousness into the world




Untangling Adam Eternal life

Rom 5:21 so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

And death is defeated by eternal life







Untangling Adam Romans 5:12-21

Through Adam, physical death came to all

Through Jesus, eternal life is offered to all

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
